# ZCS-GROW Summer Day Camp Frequently Asked Questions K – 6<sup>th</sup> Grade

# How do I enroll my child for camp?

Register online through the Zionsville Community Schools' website (<a href="http://zcsgrow.zcs.k12.in.us">http://zcsgrow.zcs.k12.in.us</a>) by clicking the EZChild Track link. Click on register and select Summer Camp or Universal Preschool Summer Camp from the drop-down menu.

# Can I sign my child up for only a few days a week?

We are not offering occasional care this summer; you must register for the full week. You must pay for a full week regardless of how many days your child is at camp.

#### Where is sumer camp located?

All of our summer programs are held at Zionsville West Middle School. 5565 S. 700 E. Whitestown, IN 46075

#### Is there a I'Camp parent meeting?

There will be no in-person meeting as in years past. A video presentation will be available to parents to answer any camp questions. There will be a Z'Camp parent Q&A Teams meeting on May 24th, 2023. # Can I drop my child off at any time?

Campers can attend from 7:30AM to 5:50PM. The program day is 9:00AM to 4:00PM. There will be modified BAC. Children will stay in pods and activities will rotate to them. During the program period K-6 campers may be off campus on a field trip, swimming, or at a local park. If you need to pick up early, notify the Camp Nurse at <a href="mailto:ZCAMPNurse@zcs.k12.in.us">ZCAMPNurse@zcs.k12.in.us</a> or call the Z'CAMP Main Office 317-733-4842.

There will be a parent signature required at all off-site location pickups.

#### Are there any restrictions for what I send in my child's lunch?

We prefer you to limit the sugar content of items and avoid soda pop. Follow the same lunch packing you follow during the school year. (We do not refrigerate lunches, but they will be in an air-conditioned space.) We are a "nut separated" program. There will be nut-free seating.

#### What happens if my child forgets his/her lunch?

We will attempt to contact you so that you can bring it to ZWEST before lunch. However, we will have emergency lunch items and water available if needed.

#### Can I send a snack with my child?

Yes, feel free to send a non-perishable, healthy snack with your child. K-6 campers will receive an afternoon snack. Preschool campers receive two snacks per day.

#### Will my preschool camper be require to nap?

All preschoolers will be required to take a 30 minute rest time on their cot.

#### What should my camper bring to camp?

K-6 campers: send your camper with their lunch, refillable water bottle, fishing hat, swimwear, flip flops, goggles, and a beach towel on swimming days. Preschool campers will need a lunch and personal nap items (nap items should not exceed a 2 gallon bag). All preschool campers should bring a change of clothes and a water bottle (please label with their name). Please note sunscreen will be provided for your preschool age camper.

Does my child have to participate in swimming at the Zionsville Aquatic Center? We will participate in swimming at the Zionsville Aquatic Center. All children will swim unless they have a note from a physician. Beginner lessons will be water exploration. Green and yellow swimmers will receive lessons as the instructor can remain on the pool deck.

# How will the aquatic center know my child's swim ability?

The aquatic center staff tests all campers the first day of swim and assigns them to swim groups. (Green mark allows access to ALL pools, yellow mark allows access to diving well, red mark allows access to the shallow instructional pool only.) Lifeguards monitor camper's access by their green/yellow/red marks on the back of their hand. Campers can "test" into the green area once they can jump in and swim the front or back crawl continuously for 25 yards in the lap pool.

Can my preschooler take part in the swimming lessons at the aquatic center? Children who are **4 years old and fully potty trained** will have the option of participating in swimming lessons. These will be held in the morning on Tuesday and Thursday from 11:30am-12:30pm.

#### What should my camper leave at home?

All electronic items (tablets, trading cards, cell phones, toys, personal gaming devices) and any other personal items are highly discouraged as we cannot be responsible for broken or lost items. Trading cards of any type.

# What should my camper wear to camp?

Please send your camper in comfortable play clothes and close toed sneakers (no sandals or Keens) as camp will be a very active environment and your child will be participating in many physical activities. Your child can put on flip flops to go to and from the pool.

#### When is the first day of Day Camp?

Day Camp will begin May 31st.

#### What is the procedure for dropping off and picking up my camper each day?

There will be two morning drop-off times. The first is 7:30-7:45am and the second is 8:30-8:45am. Afternoon pick-up is anytime from 4:15-5:30pm. If you need to pick-up or drop-off outside of the scheduled times, you will need to contact the nurse's office at 317-696-9533 and go to door 1. The scheduled drop-off and pick-up will both be at door 4. Parents or approved adults will park and come inside with their camper when dropping them off. They will check-in with a staff member and the camper will be taken to their POD room. When picking up, parents or approved adults will come inside and give the camper's name to a staff member who will then radio for the camper.

Only adults listed on your child's registration form can pick up your child. If we need to add an adult to your child's authorized pickup list, please e-mail no later than 24 hours before the pick-up. The authorized person should be prepared to provide the camp staff with a photo ID.

# How are daily medications handled at camp?

Camp nurses will be avaliable at the carline during drop-off to receive medication. We have a camp nurse on staff who will administer medications and first aid. Please complete the medication form from the <u>Z'CAMP website</u>. This form will go directly to our nurses.

# Are you closed for any holidays this summer?

Camp will be closed on Monday June 19<sup>th</sup> for Juneteenth and Monday July 3<sup>rd</sup> and Tuesday July 4<sup>th</sup> for the Fouth of July.

Can my child also attend an Eagle Recreation and Enrichment camp this summer? YES!! We can transport your K – 6 child to and from their selected course at no additional charge as long as they are registered for Z'Camp that week. Please go to <a href="http://eaglerec.zcs.k12.in.us">http://eaglerec.zcs.k12.in.us</a> and click on the summer camps icon for Z'ERE opportunities. The bus shuttle runs from 8am to 4:00pm. If your camp is outside of that timeframe, we will not be able to transport.

#### Do I need to fill out a transportation form for every Eagle Rec program my child attends?

Yes. Every Eagle Rec program needs its own transportation form. For example, if your child is attending Minecraft Camp June  $5^{th}$  –  $9^{th}$  from 10:30-11:30am and attending Princess Camp July  $17^{th}$  –  $21^{st}$  from 2:00-3:00pm you will need to fill out 2 transportation forms, one for Minecraft Camp and one for Princess Camp. # Will my child be participating in field trips?

All K-6 students will be participating in one field trip per week during weeks 1-9. Preschool will participate in 2 field trips each week of the summer. K-6<sup>th</sup> grade will participate in 5 destination field trips during weeks 10 and 11 (8/2, 8/3, 8/4, 8/7, and 8/8).

# Are there any academic programs held during summer camp?

We will be offering enrichment activities all summer long. Campers will participate in our own summer reading program at Z'Camp.

# What is the CIT program?

The CIT program is available to all students who are entering the 7th-8th grade and will consist of leadership training where students will gain experience working with children in grades K – 6. Students must apply, be interviewed and accepted into the CIT program before being permitted to register. Students are able to attend all field trips and act as counselors in training assigned to groups with adult counselors. CIT's will assist in swimming activities. Daily activities also include sports crafts, drama, games and creative play. CIT's will also enjoy leadership time together with the Program Director. CIT's must commit to camp for the entire week from 9am - 4:00pm. Price per week: \$125. Application can be found on the camp website at zcamponline.com under the CIT tab.
