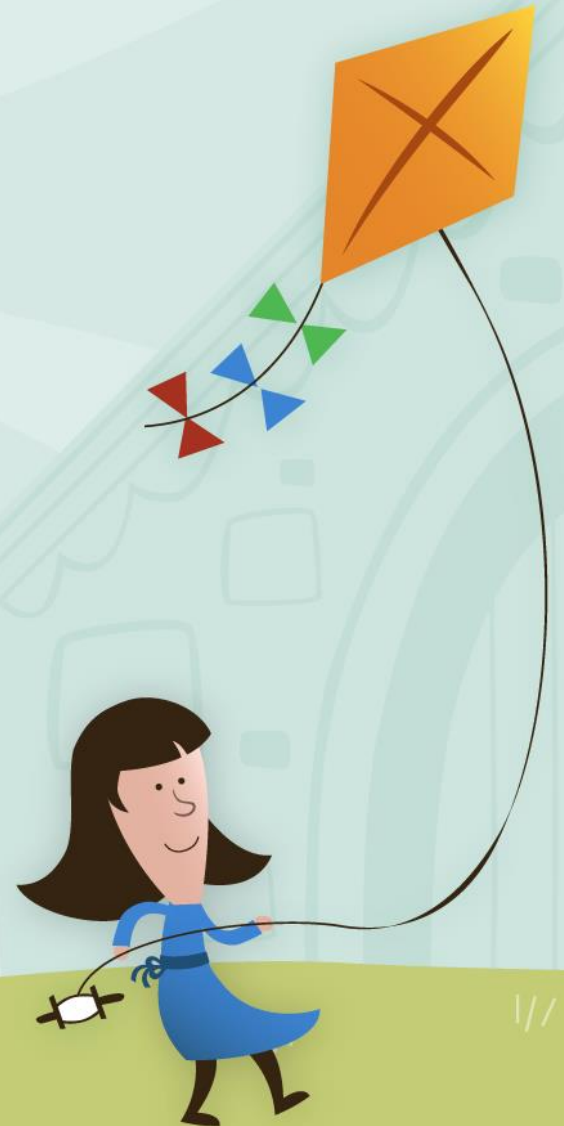

Z'Camp 2024 Practices

- Arrival and Dismissal for Z'Camp 2024 will be at Door 4
 - Enter by the Zionsville Fire Department
 - Drop-Off: 7:30-8:45
 - Pick-up: 4:00-5:30
 - Any transportation changes outside of these times must be communicated with Z'Camp staff at (317) 733-4842.
 - Parents and caregivers will need to park and exit their vehicles to walk campers inside.
 - Upon arrival, campers will be greeted and checked in by staff. At dismissal, parents or caregivers will check their camper out with a staff member who will then call for your camper from their assigned area.
- K-6th camper groups
 - Your camper's group number will stay the same all summer
 - Each group will have an assigned area in Z'West where they will keep their belongings

2024 Z'Camp Hours

- Z'Camp opens at 7:30am
- Z'Camp closes at 5:30pm
- BAC time (7:30-9:00am & 4:00-5:30pm) will be held in group pods.
 - Pods consist of 3 groups of similar grade level.
 - Pods will attend field trips together.



Lunch

- New to camp this summer, we will have the option for your camper to buy a lunch
 - No need to sign up in advance
 - Lunch includes an entrée, fruit, vegetable, treat, and beverage for a cost of \$3.50
 - ZCS Campers will use their lunch code
 - Non-ZCS Campers' parents will receive communication from Jan about their balance and payments
- Sack lunches will not be available to campers going on field trips.

Counselor Groups

Preschool

- Our Z'Camp Preschool staff to camper ratio is 1:10.

K-6th Z'Camp

- 15 Groups, 2-3 counselors per group, CITs in some K-3rd grade groups
 - Groups 1-6 = Kindergarten & 1st Grade
 - Groups 7-12 = 2nd & 3rd Grade
 - Groups 13-14 = 4th Grade
 - Group 15 = 5th & 6th Grade "JAM Camp"
- 18-20 campers present per group except for group 15

We cannot honor requests for friends or counselors.



Field Trips

- Special Info for Week 9 Field Trips
 - Camp Hours: 8:30-5:30
 - Morning drop-off: 8:30-9:00
 - Campers will go directly from their vehicle to an assigned location for their group. (Directly to the bus if weather requires.)
 - Evening pick-up: 5-5:30
 - Campers will be divided into 5 groups based on their PODs. Each group will rotate through a series of 5 different field trips. Each group visiting each location once.
 - Field trips will be all-day trips. Campers will not be available for pick-up/drop-off between 9:00am and 5:00pm.



Swim

- Swim days for preschool-6th grade campers can be found on our website zcamponline.com
 - K-6th Grade->Group Swim Schedule
 - Preschool->Preschool Daily Schedule
- K-6th campers will have their swim ability evaluated on their group's first day of swimming at Z'Camp.
- One-piece suits or "tankini" required.
- Swim instructors will be in the pool and a lifeguard will be on duty while the pool is in use
 - **RED** swimmers will utilize the shallow training pool
 - **YELLOW** swimmers will be in the dive pool
 - **GREEN** swimmers will be in the lap pool
- Only preschoolers who are 4 years old will be permitted to participate in play-based activities at the ZCS pool.
- 3 year old campers will participate in "Big Buddy" day at Z'West.



Z' Camp Activities

- K-6th weekly activities include, but are not limited to: archery, fishing, crafts, STEM, yoga, camping, lacrosse, track & field, golf, Gaga ball, song/dance, floor hockey, tee ball, cooking, flag football, swimming, other gym games, nature activities, SGE playground, pickle ball, Strong in Every Way, 9 Square in the Air and more!
- Preschool activities include: BME and SGE playgrounds, swim or water activities, craft, cooking, nature walks, gym, song/dance, track and more!



Daily Camper Needs

- **Please put your child's name on everything!!!!**
- Shoes *MUST* be closed toed/heeled or they cannot participate in select activities.
- Apply sunscreen and bug spray each morning. Z'Camp will supply sunscreen for reapplication during the day for all campers Preschool and K-6th.
- Water bottle – put your camper's name on water bottles. Water bottles are important for your camper.
- Lunch – disposable bags for field trips. Lunch boxes may be sent in on other days.
- Put a hat in the backpack for fishing days.
- Remember swim gear – suits, towel, goggles, flip flops

St. Vincent Z'Camp Nurses

- We will have 2 ZCS school nurses at Z'Camp on campus
 - Jae Donathen
 - Keiona Cox-K'Peahay
- Parents must fill out a medical information form to send medicine to Z'Camp. Link: <https://www.zcamponline.com/medauthorization-form>
 - Medication (including but not limited to cough drops, Ibuprofen/Tylenol, acetaminophen, Zyrtec, Pepto-Bismol, ADHD meds, and anti-anxiety meds) must be given to nurses at drop-off – please do not put into backpacks
- Be on the lookout for emails/calls from our nurses regarding your child's health and other important information

Zionsville Eagle Recreation and Enrichment (Z'ERE)

- K-6th campers who are registered for Z'ERE courses can be transported for FREE via ZCS yellow school bus from camp to their location.

- Parents must communicate transportation needs via the Z'ERE form [here](#)** by the *Friday before* the week that the Z'ERE course begins. For last minute changes, contact Cole Tamburini at (317) 524-8704 or ntamburini@zcs.k12.in.us Every Eagle Rec program needs its own transportation form. For example, if your child is attending Minecraft Camp June 5th – 9th from 10:30-11:30am and attending Princess Camp July 17th – 21st from 2:00-3:00pm you will need to fill out 2 transportation forms, one for Minecraft Camp and one for Princess Camp.

- This service operates from 9:00am to 4:00pm Monday – Friday. If your child needs to be picked up outside of that window it will be the parent's responsibility to transport.

- It is **very important** to communicate Z'ERE courses to the Zionsville Eagle Rec Coordinator as the programs are not linked in the registration processes.

- We do not transport preschool campers to Z'ERE programs.
